- Electronically submitting the application by 11:59 p.m. on March 5, 2015
- Mailing the following required supporting documents to Scholarship Management Services by the postmark deadline of March 5, 2015:
 - High school seniors and first year college students must submit their high school transcripts.
 - Applicants currently in their second, third or fourth year of college must submit their college transcripts.
 - Grade reports are not accepted. Unofficial transcripts must contain the student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course and the term in which the course was taken.
 - Two (2) completed Applicant Appraisal Forms (available on the application website).
 - Page one of the Student Aid Report (SAR) from most recent FAFSA filing. SAR must be from the most recent FAFSA filing and include the applicant's first and last name, academic year and the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).

The following documents are required by the high school counselor or principal:

- Form G
- Counselor Evaluation/Academic Information Form for each student applicant.
